Tender # 17-NRP-17-00006 MI 14020 - Street Upgrades 2022

This tender represents three projects.

Project A is for upgrading the access road to the new sewage treatment plant and includes the installation of a stormwater catch basin, concrete curb and asphalt to the end of adjacent properties on Bannock Street, reshaping of existing roadway surface and granular upgrades to the access road for the tendered amount of \$312,568.85.

Project B is for street resurfacing which includes asphalt removal and resurfacing with one lift of asphalt from the intersection of Roe Avenue and Garrett Drive up to approximately the end of property boundary at 60 Ward Street for the tendered price of \$345,375.48.

Project C is the continuation of Dickens Street extension which was started last construction season. This new phase includes the placement of granular subgrade, concrete curb and one lift of asphalt for the tendered price of \$319,527.55.

There were three bids received with the lowest that met specifications being received from Springdale Forest Resources Inc. in the combined amount of \$977,471.88 HST Inclusive.
