Contract Change Order #1 – Gander Sports Complex

Although Geotechnical work including test pits and soils analysis were carried out prior to the start of the Gander Sports Complex, during excavation, organic material, deemed unsuitable for the placement of sports complex was encountered. The Consultant in conjunction with the contractor, geotechnical experts and the Town worked together to find a solution that would keep the project on schedule while ensuring a solid foundation for the new facility. It was recommended that sections of unsuitable material be removed and geotextile material combined with structural fill placed as subgrade.

It was fortunate that most of the materials required for this solution were available in close proximity to the project and a result there were no significant delays in the schedule.

These proposed lines will be permanently stitched into the synthetic turf and will not require annual maintenance.
