Tender Summary #20-10, Cobb's Pond Phase III

The Town issued a tender for the Cobb's Pond Phase III development. Four (4) tenders were received with the lowest bid non-compliant. The second lowest bid that met specifications was submitted by East-Glo Electric Ltd in the amount of \$199,955.10 tax inclusive.

This was \$32,636.86 over budget.

Tender Summary #20-10, Cobb's Pond Phase III

Moved by Councillor Fudge and seconded by Councillor Dove that the tender for Cobb's Pond Phase III be awarded to East-Glo Electric Ltd for the amount of \$199,955.10 tax inclusive.

WHEREAS 60 days have passed since the posting and service of the Notice of Arrears and the tax account remains outstanding;

Tax Arrears Sale – 31 McCurdy Drive

Moved by Councillor Brown and seconded by Councillor Fudge that the Property be sold by public auction in accordance with section 141 of the Municipalities Act, 1999

Fire Truck

The Minister of Municipal Affairs and Environment has offered the Town of Gander a cost-shared agreement for the purchase of a new 4 Door Pumper Truck. The total cost is \$385,000 of which 60% of the cost would be covered by the Provincial Government and 40% by the Town of Gander. There will be a formal Funding Agreement presented to the Committee.

Motion #20-137 Fire Truck

Moved by Councillor Dove and seconded by Deputy Mayor Pollett that the Town of Gander accept the funding proposal from the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Environment for the cost shared purchase of a 4 Door Pumper Truck as attached.

The Mayor asked if this was a budgeted item. The Director of Finance advised that the item was budgeted in previous years Capital Budget and will require adjustment in the 2021 Budget.
