

• Council engaged in conversation to develop change to Development Regulations to accommodate the need for short-term rentals. The province now requires Municipal approval prior to issuance of a licence for this type of occupancy. Govt of NL recently introduced the Tourism Accommodation Act, which will outline rules for the operation of short-term accommodations. Platforms such as Airbnb and VRBO have become very popular yet require oversight. These platforms have had disruptive impact on traditional hospitality industry. The secondary focus is to ensure that there is fairness in economic considerations of all accommodation providers through an equitable taxation structure.

of Gander and NL Health Services. The Town welcomes new staff joining the OBS unit, pledging to foster a supportive community that encourages collaboration and inclusion. The leadership of Premier Furey, Minister Osborne, and Minister Haggie, along with the actions and commitment of The Citizens Health Action Committee and Mayor's Advisory group all played a pivotal role.
