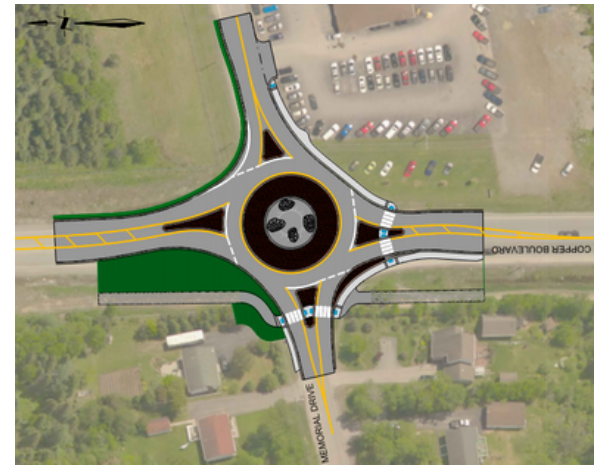


## Cooper Boulevard Roundabout

Construction has begun for a new roundabout at the intersection of Cooper Blvd and Memorial Dr.

This initiative comes in response to increased traffic on Cooper Boulevard, with funding allocated during the 2024 budget process. A comprehensive report by traffic engineers recommended the roundabout as the best solution to improve long-term safety at this busy intersection. The project is cost-shared through provincial Multi-Year Capital Works funding.

The Town understands that the introduction of a roundabout in the community may cause uncertainty. The Town of Gander is committed to providing ongoing information and educational resources to ensure a smooth transition.
