Proclamations:

• Municipal Awareness Week (May 4–10, 2025)

Planning and Public Works Report (Feb 25 – Mar 25, 2025):

- 4 residential permits issued (3 single-family dwellings, 1 apartment unit)
- Ongoing infrastructure and facility projects

- Approved a 4-unit discretionary apartment development at 28 Waterton Street
- Approved \$60,225 in Housing Accelerator Fund (HAF) support for residential conversion at 81 Elizabeth Drive
- Approved \$20,078 in HAF support for a secondary suite at 66 Bennett Drive
