POSITION 1

The Town of Gander's Fire & Emergency Services Department is seeking a student to help beautify the town by painting some of the 325 fire hydrants around town. The duties would include painting and stenciling the hydrant number onto the hydrant as well assist with fire hydrant testing.

POSITION 2

The Town of Gander's Community Services Department is seeking a student to help with maintenance and landscaping of Cobb's Pond Rotary Park. Duties would include a variety of tasks, including but not limited to, tree trimming, minor grass cutting, weed control, scrubs, flowers, general clean up, minor painting, watering of plants and walkway sweeping. Must be able to operate small hand tools and equipment such as grass trimmer, lawn mower, drill, etc.

Qualifications

- Open to the student finishing Grade 10, 11 or 12 in June 2025.
- Have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.
- Cannot be an immediate family member of the Board of Directors or operators of the organization.
- Successful applicants for position #2 will require a code of conduct.

The successful applicant will work 25 hours per week and receive \$16.00 per hour plus 4% vacation pay. The position will start on or before July 2nd for a period of 5 weeks.
