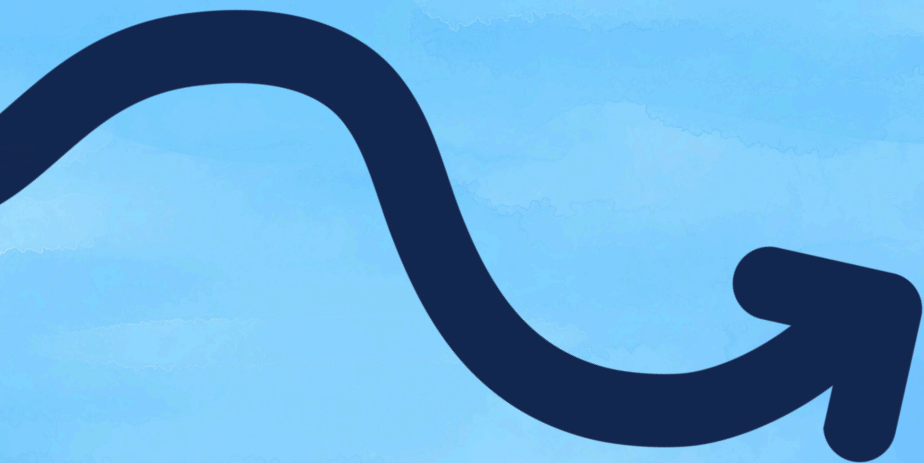




Clean Up Week Guide

May 4-15, 2026



What you need to know:

- We'll collect items once a week on your regular garbage day
- Do not place items outside designated days
- Improperly sorted items will not be collected
- Small items must be contained

What will not be collected:

- Rocks, gravel or concrete
- Electronics
- Grass, trees, or leaves
- Hazardous waste (propane tanks, paint, pesticides, oil, etc.)
- Vehicle tires

How to sort your items:

Pile 1

Regular household garbage & recyclables



Pile 2

Metals, including large appliances



Pile 3

Branches, tied and bundled (max. 50 lb, 5 ft lengths)



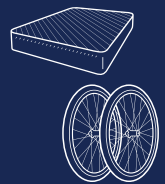
Pile 4

Construction/ demolition materials: lumber, wooden furniture, etc. (max. 50 lb, 5 ft lengths)



Pile 5

Other refuse (furniture, mattresses, bicycle tires, etc.)



Please Note:

- All loose material (Gyproc, glass, shingles, ceramic tiles, etc.) must be placed in appropriate containers (max. 50 lb per container). Vinyl siding must be bundled (max. 50 lb, 5 ft lengths).
- Broken glass must be clearly marked and properly contained.
