Council Highlights

Council Update

Councillor Tara Pollett was elected Deputy Mayor. Council adopted a new three-week meeting cycle for the remainder of 2025.



Community Partnerships

Council approved \$500 for the Central Business Connections conference, \$1,500 for the NL Antique and Classic Car Club Central Meet, and \$500 for the NL Housing & Homelessness Network provincial conference.



Planning and Development

Council approved a variance for a 6.05 m garage at 4 MacLean Place, exceeding the permitted height by 10%.



Governance and Finance

Council gave first reading to the Arrears Sale By-Law and approved one property tax reduction of \$598.44, bringing the 2025 total to \$20,899.41.



Infrastructure and Technology

Council awarded Bell a contract for a new VoIP phone system at \$13.77 per line/month and approved \$19,553.82 plus HST for culverts at the Gander Golf Course.
