



The Town has partnered with FoodCycle Science to offer compost units at a subsidized rate.

The FoodCycler is a countertop composter that uses heat to grind down unwanted food scraps much faster than a traditional backyard composter - one cycle takes about 4-9 hours to produce a nutrient filled mulch.


2025 Waste Transfer Schedule

Council Highlights

NOTABLE ITEMS

- Planning and Public Works Report (July 16 August 12, 2025):
 - 3 new residential builds started, creating 5 new dwelling units.
 - Building permit values for this period totaled \$1.4M; \$17.7M YTD.
 - 27 compliance letters issued.
 - 32 tonnes of asphalt used for street repairs.
- Development Highlights:
 - Approved quarry operation 3 km north of Gander.
 - Entered new Habitat Conservation Agreement covering the Northwest Peatlands and Thomas Howe Forest.
- Home Based Business Applications:
 - Advanced Foot Care Services at 37 Penwell Avenue home office only, with off-site client visits.
- Procurement Highlights
 - Ozone generator system upgrades: €24,594 (~\$39,842 CAD)
- Strategic Initiatives:
 - Sport tourism field fees waived for eligible youth events in 2025.
 - Project Dashboard launched on website for real-time updates on Town projects.
 - Town entered agreement to support municipal habitat conservation.
 - Council's End-of-Term Progress Report released ahead of Oct. 2 election.
